Contractors/Bidders are advised to follow the instructions provided in the “Instructions to the Contractors/Bidders for the e-submission of the bids online through the Central Public Procurement Portal for e-Procurement at <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>” in the Annexure - 8. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

4. Bidders shall not tamper/modify the tender form including downloaded financial bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tempered/modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and bidder is liable to be banned from doing business with Office of Development Commissioner for Handlooms .

5. Intending tenderers are advised to visit National Handloom development Corporation's website [www.nhdc.org.in](http://www.nhdc.org.in) and CPPP site <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> regularly till closing date of submission of tender for any corrigendum / addendum/ amendment.

6. EMD and Bid document cost:

## **INTRODUCTION**

National Handloom Development Corporation Ltd (A Govt. of India Undertaking) working under the aegis of Development Commissioner for Handloom, Ministry of Textiles, Govt. of India, New Delhi has been taking a number of measures to provide Marketing support to the handloom weavers in marketing their products by arranging Exhibition cum Sale besides other measures at various Metropolitan cities every year. Participants from various states, Apex Bodies, Primary Handloom Weavers Societies etc. participate in these Expo.

NHDC on behalf of the O/o Development Commissioner for Handlooms, Ministry of Textiles, Government of India is going to organize National Level Special Handloom Expos (Silk Fab/ Wool Fab/ Expo) during the financial year 2019-20. Tenders/ Quotations are invited from the reputed contractors for the infrastructural work.

## **1. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. (a) NHDC conducts the Special Handloom Expos on behalf of office of DC (Handlooms), Ministry of Textiles. Only the Parties capable of providing infrastructure material of Octonum System and having good experience of executing similar type of work for Govt. Organisation, Trade Fair etc are eligible to apply. The online tendre shall be submitted in two bids.
  - (i) **Technical Bid**
  - (ii) **Financial Bid**
- (b) Online submission of Tender after the stipulated date and time on account of any reason shall not be entertained.
- (c) **Financial bid of only those tenderer would be opened who fulfill the qualification criteria and are declared qualified in Technical Bid.**
- (d) In order to arrange wider applicants,tenderer is allowed to quote for either group- A or Group- B.
2. Tenderer should quote the rate for each specified items mentioned in the financial bid and rates if quoted in vague manner, or in any other type/form which differ from the specified item, are liable not to be considered. Rates quoted should be clear in meaning and reference.
3. Duration of the Exhibition at each place is only for 14 days, however in case of extension of the same for less than three days no extra payment shall be made and in case it is extended for more than three days, the payment for extended days shall be made at the rate not exceeding proportionate cost for 14 days. The space for commencement of the work relating to the erection of stall and other Electrical Work shall be made available 2 days in advance and shall have to be completd by the contractor atleast 12 Hrs. before the commencement of event. The progress of work shall be supervised and checked by the authorised representatives of the NHDC Limited. Tenderers **MUST** inspect the site for physical condition before planning/execution of work order.
4. In case of any portion of infrastructure work is not completed as per laid down standard and handed over to the authority, penalty upto 5% of the total value of the work allotted / awarded shall be imposed by the authority for each day of delay.
5. The volume of the work may vary according to the actual requirement at the site which shall be at the discretion of the Corporation, and final payment to the contractor shall be regulated on the basis of actual work executed at the rates initially approved.
6. The Contractor shall be responsible for upkeep & daily cleaning of exhibition Hall inside (atleast two times a day) by vacuum cleaner during the entire exhibition period and maintenance of the entire work done by him, till the closing of the exhibition for which no extra payment shall be made. Breakage/damage, if any, infrastructure work shall immediately be rectified and no extra payment shall be made for the same.

7. The Contractor is not allowed to sublet whole or part of the contract without the prior written permission from the Corporation.
8. With regards to electrical fitting etc. the contractor shall have to engage a qualified licensed electrical contractor entitled to erect, handle and maintain high tension supply line and its maintenance and up-keeps.
9. No Advance/part payment shall be made to the contractor. Final payment will be made only after the satisfactory completion of the works of the exhibitions and on submission of proper bills/documents etc. duly certified by the NHDC incharge of the exhibition.
10. The tenderer should fill the rate tendered in figures as well as in words. The tender form may be filled in English. Over writing in rates is not permitted . All correctionson each page of the tender form and other related papers submittd therewith should be signed by the tenderer on each page of the tender form and other related papers submitted therewith be signed by the tenderer.Rates should be quoted item wise as shown in schedule and all applicable taxes and duties levied by Government should be clearly metioned by tenderer separately.
11. Agencies are required to submit proof of an Earnest Money of Rs.1,00,000.00 in the mode of Demand Draft/FDR, drawn in favour of the NHDC Limited and Tender Cost of Rs. 500.00 in the mode of Demand Draft at office of NHDC Ltd.,Wegmans Business Park,4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Plot no. 3 Sector Knowledge Park-III Surajpur- Kasna Main Road, Greater Noida-201306 (U.P.). 12. The earnest mony of successful tenderer will be retained as security for successful completion of the contracts and shall be returned without any interest after all exhibitions are over.
13. It is proposed to organise Special Handloom Expo “Silk Fab”/“Wool Fab/Expo” at 28 places. The Corporation has a right to cancel one or more or all events at any moment without assigning any reason what so ever or change the date of the events/contractor for any event. No compensation at all against such losses if any, will be given to the Contractor for the events concerned.
14. The successful tenderer shall immediately and not later than next three days of intimation of acceptance of tender, sign and return a copy of order as acceptance of the order, terms & conditions of the Corporation. Failure to do so shall give the Corporation the right to revoke the acceptance of the tender without further notice to the tenderer, forfeit the earnest money deposit and award the work to any other contractor.
15. The Corporation reserve the right to reject any or all tenders and award the remaining work to any other contractor without assigning any reason. Conditional tenders in any form, whatsoever shall be liable to be rejected outrightly.
16. The Corporation shall be entitle to cancel the contract, if it is found that there has been any breach of condition of the contract and/or the work is found to be unsatisfactory. The Contractor in such cases will not be entitled for making any claim/compensation. The Corporation is entitled to forfeit the earnest money and the contractor may not be considered for award of any similar contract in future.

17. The contractor is responsible for observing all the relevant labour laws in force during the execution of the contract. For works outside the work order, contractor will have to quote rates separately. For all such works the Corporation reserves the right to pay the lowest of the rates quoted by the competing contractors or on the basis of assessment of reasonable market rates.
18. In some cities, the selected hall/venue may have the terms/conditions, that only the agencies empanelled with them are allowed for Infrastructure Work in their Hall. In such circumstances, NHDC Ltd will be at liberty to award work order to such agency and NHDC's Contractor shall not be entitled for any compensaton etc.
19. In case of any dispute or differences, breach & violation relating to the terms of the contract, the said matter or dispute, differences shall be referred to MD, NHDC for arbitration, who himself or any other person appointed by him will work as sole arbitrator and the award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.
20. The rates of all items of work shall include cost of all labour, transportation, octroi and all type of taxes etc.
21. MSME/NSIC/DIC etc are examped for Tender fee and Security deposit

## **2.PERIOD OF CONTRACT**

- a) The contract will be valid for a period of One year initially.
- b) On expiry of One year, NHDC reserves the right to extend the contract further on the same terms & conditions as mutually agreed in writing if the service of the agency found satisfactory.

## **3. TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT**

- a. NHDC may terminate the contract without assigning any cause by giving three months' notice in writing. However, the notice period may be extended by mutual agreement till alternate arrangements are made. Further, any pending or unresolved service, function, task, performance, unpaid fees and any other remedies shall continue by both the parties during the period of termination notice and the same must be satisfied before this agreement is terminated.
- b. The Agency shall have no claim to any payment or compensation whatsoever on account of any profit or advantage, which would have derived from the execution of the work in full, but which he did not derive in consequences the full amount of the work not having been carried out, neither shall he have any claim on compensation / damage for the loss suffered by him by reason of termination of agreement by the NHDC
- c. NHDC without prejudice to any other remedy, reserves the right to terminate the Tender / Contract in whole or in part and also to blacklist the Agency for a suitable period without giving any notice in case he fails to honour his bid or contract without sufficient grounds or found guilty for breach of condition /s of the tender or contract, negligence, carelessness, inefficiency, fraud, mischief and misappropriation or any other type of misconduct by agency or by its staff or agent. NHDC's decision in such a situation shall be final and shall be accepted by the service provider without any objection or resistance. In such case of termination, NHDC will have the right to put in place any other agency for carrying out the remaining enrolment work. Any extra expenditure shall be recovered from the agency.
- d. If the successful bidder withdraws or the services provided by the successful bidder are not found satisfactory (say in a month or so) during the probationary period of three months from the date of taking over charge, NHDC reserves the right to terminate the contract without giving any notice and initiate appropriate necessary action in the matter for making alternate arrangements.

## **4. SECURITY DEPOSIT**

Security deposit / performance guarantee of **Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees: One Lakh Only)** in the form of bank guarantee from scheduled Bank is to be submitted by the Agency immediately within 7 days of the execution of the agreement to cover any loss or damage caused to or suffered by NHDC due to acts of commission and omission by the Agency or any failure on the part of Agency in fulfilment of terms and conditions of the contract and conditions contained in the agreement. The bank guarantee should be valid up to three months beyond the expiry of contract period.

## **5. PAYMENT TERMS**

Once the bills will receive than only the payment will be made through RTGS/NEFT.



**6. INDEMNITY**

The agency hereby covenants and agrees to indemnify and shall at all times keep indemnified NHDC against any loss or damage that NHDC may sustain as a result of the failure or neglect of the Bidders to faithfully carry out its obligations under this agreement or negligence, carelessness, inefficiency, fraud, mischief and misappropriation or any other type of misconduct of the Agency or its employees, agents, representatives and further to pay for all losses, damages, costs, charges and expenses which NHDC may reasonably incur or suffer, and to indemnify and keep indemnified NHDC in all respects.

**7. FORCE MAJEURE**

If any time, during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party under obligation as per this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of any war or hostility, act of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fire, flood, explosion, epidemic, quarantine restrictions, strike, lockout or acts of God (herein after referred to "eventuality"), provided notice of happening of any such eventuality is given by either party to the other within 21 days of the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall be reason of such an "eventuality" be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and deliveries under the contract. The contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such "eventuality" has come to an end or cease to exist. In case of any dispute, the decision of Chief Executive & Officiating Secretary of NHDC shall be final and conclusive, provided further that if the performance in whole or part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such eventuality for a period exceeding 60 days, either party may at its option, terminate the contract. Provided also that if the contract is terminated under this clause NHDC shall be at liberty to take over from the Agency at a price to be fixed by the NHDC, which shall be final, all unused, undamaged and acceptable materials, bought out components and other stores in the course of operation which may be in the possession of the agency at the time of such termination, or such portion thereof as NHDC may deem, fit except such material, as the agency may, with the concurrence of the NHDC, elect to retain.

**8. ARBITRATION**

- I. In the event of any dispute difference, claims and demands arising between NHDC and the agency in any matter arising in relation or connection or pursuant or touching to the meaning, operation, effect or interpretation of this tender / agreement directly or indirectly, the matter shall be referred to the Secretary of NHDC who may himself act as sole arbitrator or may name as sole arbitrator an officer of NHDC notwithstanding the fact that such officer has been directly or indirectly associated with this contract. The decision / award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties. Cost of Arbitration will be shared equally by the parties.
- II. The place of the arbitration shall be at New Delhi/NCR.
- III. The Arbitration proceeding shall be governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act of 1996 as amended from time to time.
- IV. The proceedings of arbitration shall be in English language.

**9. JURISDICTION**

In respect of any dispute arising between NHDC and the agency in any matter covered / touched this tender / contract or arising directly or indirectly there from or connected or concerned with the said contract, the courts at Delhi/NCR shall only have the jurisdiction.
